

Further to the statement we issued on 31st May 2012 (Below)

Following a meeting on Thursday 31st May with Father Alan Burbidge and St Georges Church, the DJ Trust has been asked to cover the burial costs and headstones of the six young children. The Co-Op is meeting the funeral director costs as all the children are under the age of 16, and additional services offered in kind will provide for other elements of the funeral, including transport for the 6 young children and flowers, as well as the Parish of St Georges church assisting.

The DJ Trust was established to receive and manage the many generous donations of support, both in kind and financial, which were pledged to towards the funeral of the six young children. As such, the DJ trust and account held by Lloyds/TSB, will close 14 days after the funeral. At this point a full statement of accounts will be published to illustrate how the funds have been spent. Any fundraising activities set to take place following the closure of the trust, we would respectfully request are pledged to an appropriate charity in the memory of Duwayne, Jade, John, Jack, Jessie and Jayden.

The funeral of the six children is clearly a private matter and is being coordinated by St Georges Church with the family; however the DJ Trust would like to thank the community who have and continue to raise funds through the trusts account, which has enabled the local community to contribute towards laying to rest these 6 young beautiful children.
